5. Ron Brooks cancelled the range cleanup for March 16th and was unsure of March 23rd due to snow/weather.
6. Membership Officer Dave Lawrence did not give a membership report. Marc Lindahl introduced himself as a new prospective member.

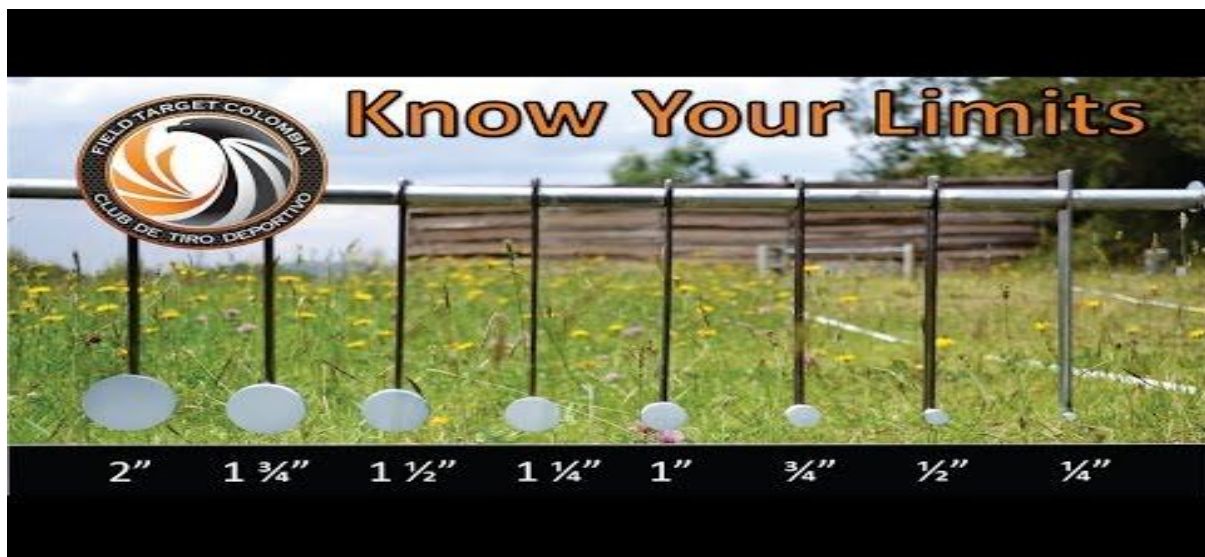
7. Old Business - A short discussion on the baffles was made. The club had not made a down payment as of the meeting, but has done so since the March 2019 general meeting.
