b. Dave Lawrence made a motion to have Koch's do some dirt work at the range. Some of the berms are sliding down and the lake south of the target shed continues to be a problem. A drainage ditch will be dug on the east side and the water holding pit will be improved. The total cost for this project is to not exceed \$2600. Leon Jansen 2nd the motion which passed. There was also a short discussion about working on the parking lot, but no proposal was put forth.

c. Mike Cerney reminded the club that no one is to be driving vehicles on the 200 yard range as this leaves deep ruts which make mowing very bumpy. The only exceptions to this rule are for official match set-up and range maintenance activities.

Basic Rules for Scheduling an Event at the Columbus Rifle Club Range

1. All events must be approved by the CRC Executive Committee prior to their being placed on the club's calendar and posted on the club's website.
2. Each event must have an Event/Match Director who is "in charge " of and responsible for the event.
3. The minimum charge for participation in any match shall be at least \$5.00. A match is basically any event at the club range involving shooting of any kind. Basically, if you shoot, you pay. *(The Executive Committee may except events from the "\$5.00 Rule" at their discretion. Such events may include Hunter Safety, and Hunter Sight-In Day along with others.)*
4. The Event/Match Director is responsible for making sure everything is cleaned up at the range and put away. Leave the range better than you found it. Participants in each event should help in this part of the event.
5. The Event/Match Director shall submit a report of the event including names a CRC members who participated and an accounting of fees collected and turned into the club Treasurer.
